

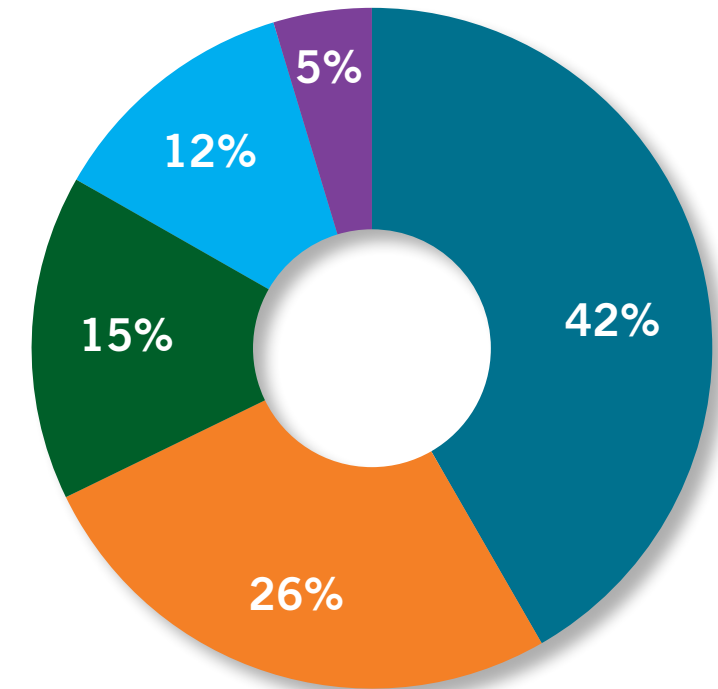

### What is the typical size and composition of the groups?

- ④ **Core / Project Groups:**  
15–20 members
- ④ **Specialist Groups:**  
Up to 30 members with sub-groups
- ④ **Composition:**  
Balanced mix of expertise, firm type, and seniority for effective collaboration

### How does this benefit the industry and members?

- ④ **Industry Impact:**  
The structure helps Irish Funds stay ahead of regulatory and operational shifts, strengthen thought leadership, and drive outcomes on critical themes.
- ④ **Member Value:**  
Ensures a strong, representative voice for the membership base while supporting meaningful engagement and collaboration.

### What criteria were used to select Working Group Members and Chairs?

- ④ **Member Selection:**  
Based on expertise, cohort alignment, gender balance, seniority diversity, and each firm's capacity to contribute.
- ④ **Chair Appointments:**  
Determined by leadership and experience, with 69% newly appointed to bring fresh perspectives and 31% returning to ensure continuity.
