

3 types of Groups

- Working Groups** – addresses Strategic and Core objectives & ongoing industry items, actively managed by IF Executive.
- Project Groups** shorter life cycle than WGs - mobilised when required for a specific deliverable in a defined timeframe or where there is short, intense work required.
- Specialist Groups** – provides venues for communities of industry professionals with specific expertise (product/functional across the value chain/ industry cohorts) to discuss and develop important and emerging industry topics and provide thought leadership to the IF Executive or wider membership.
